WHAT IS CALL2ALL?

Call2all is a world-wide movement calling the Body of Christ to renewed focus and a collaborative effort to fulfill the Great Commission.

Call2all is about all nations, all spheres of society and every unreached person in the world. It is a collaborative, strategic, pro-active movement targeting where the Church is not, rather than where it is. The purpose is not to replace existing ministry but to network, train and focus the Body of Christ to reach every person on earth in fulfillment of the Great Commission.

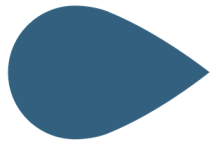

THE CALL2ALL MOVEMENT

The call2all movement has thousands of Christian leaders participating, in all walks of life from all around the globe. Many key mission organizations and denominations are included in these numbers.

Early in the development of call2all, Western leaders provided most of the initial momentum of the movement, but now key leaders from Africa, Latin America, and particularly Asia, are taking ownership and fully participating in present activity.

The first call2all Congress was held in January 2008 in Orlando, U.S.A. Since that time, Congresses have been held in almost all the major regions of the world, resulting in an extensive global network focused on the completion of the Great Commission.

Hundreds of written commitments have been made towards primary strategic goals and it has been thrilling to see many of these promised missionary activities already set in motion.

In June 2009, the first “global” congress was held in Hong Kong. Three thousand leaders participated from more than 100 countries, including hundreds from Mainland China. A second “global” Congress was held in November 2011 in Los Angeles, California, U.S.A. An exciting fruit from that Congress was major networking, especially with business and media leaders.

Several other movements contributed to the birth of call2all, including Bill Bright’s Global Pastors Network and “Table 71,” which emerged from Billy Graham’s Amsterdam 2000 event. Leaders from Campus Crusade for Christ (CCC) and Youth with A Mission (YWAM), two of the largest mission agencies in the world, have been significant contributors to the initial development of the call2all movement.

GLOBAL NETWORK

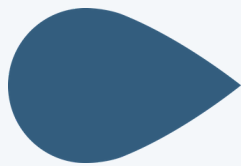

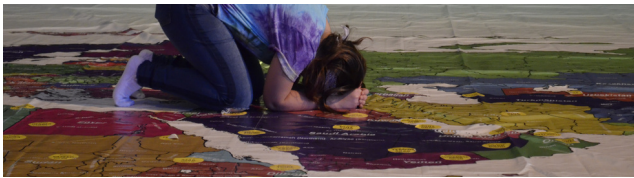

CALL2ALL 777 STRATEGY

call2all 777 discusses how to fulfill the Great Commission Through strategies related to 7 themes; 7 spheres and 7 geographic alls. This is a living document designed to educate, encourage and stir up missional thinking on how to work in all spheres of society to fulfill the Great Commission.



7 THEMES

Before Jesus left the earth, he gave us very specific assignments. We like to call these themes 'finish lines". These are things we are meant to finish as the church.

5 FINISH LINES

1. Prayer for every person
2. Proclamation of the Gospel to all
3. Scripture for all
4. Church presence for all
5. Compassion & Justice
6. Engagement of all people groups
7. Humility

CALL2ALL STRATEGY

FINISH LINES OF THE GREAT COMMISSION

Before Jesus left the earth, he gave us very specific assignments. We like to call these finish lines. These are things we are meant to finish as the church.

2. All People Groups | Engagement of every people group.

There are still A LOT of people who've never been exposed to the witness of Jesus, because of geographic inaccessibility, language, political or cultural barriers and lack of those willing 'to go'. These people groups are called Unengaged Unreached People Groups (UUPGs). We are all called to go preach the Gospel in the whole world as a testimony to all nations, and then the end will come as Jesus taught in Matt 24:14. Our goal is to have zero people groups without full time Christian workers, growing church movement and scripture available in local language both oral & written.

2. Scripture for all | Everyone having access to the Bible in their own language.

There are 7000 living languages and we have to engage people with the bible all across the earth. We know that people do not live by bread alone, but by every word that comes from the mouth of God as Jesus taught in Matt 4:4. The Bible needs to be translated and distributed in the forms that people understand. For those who do not read, we need an oral presentation. To reach the large number of people, we need technology, films, and other languages without the Bible translated and distributed in the most appropriate way for a people group: orally, digitally, or in print.

3. Church presence for all | Church presence in every neighborhood.

The goal for every community is to have a church presence where people can gather as believers close to their homes.

CALL2ALL STRATEGY

4. Proclamation of the Gospel to all | Telling everyone.

Every single person in the world needs to hear about Jesus in a way they can understand. There is still one third of the world with no access to the gospel. This is around 2 billion people! We need to go into all the world and preach the Good News to everyone as Jesus taught in Mark 16:15. Our goal is to have zero individuals who are of sufficient age and reason to understand who have not heard the good news of Jesus and His Kingdom.



5. Compassion for all | Demonstrating love in action

Jesus spoke the truth in love, and showed the truth in his actions. If we are to fully represent Christ today, we need to both proclaim his truth and demonstrate his love. James 1 challenges everyone to visit orphans and widows in their affliction, and to keep oneself unstained from the world. That is our duty and it must be done. Through practicing compassion for all, our goal is to have zero people without adequate water, food, healthcare, clothing and shelter.
